



Quimper Wildlife Corridor and Cappy's Trails

Lands in the Quimper Wildlife Corridor are protected through a partnership of Jefferson Land Trust, the City of Port Townsend, and Jefferson County. The Quimper Wildlife Corridor is a 3.5 mile greenbelt including parts of the popular "Cappy's Trails" network. The QWC links six wetlands and provides hundreds of acres of wildlife habitat and natural stormwater filtration, improving the health of the Strait of Juan de Fuca and Puget Sound.

Trail placement is approximate. Only main trails are shown; other trails may cross private land. Use caution on trails to stay on public right-of-ways. Please stay on trails to minimize impacts to wildlife and plant community.
